



Emergency Services

- ❑ **999** - Dial this number if you need: an **Ambulance, Fire Brigade, Police**, coast guard, cliff and mountain rescue . You should only call this number in an **EMERGENCY**.
- ❑ **111** - Dial this number if you are need of a **non-emergency** medical help. You will be put through to the NHS Direct Service, who will go through a list of question about your non-emergency medical situation.
- ❑ **101** - This number is for **non-emergency police**. If a crime is not currently in process, then this number is appropriate. It can also be used to give information about a crime that has already been committed.
