Emergency Services

999 - Dial this number if you need: an Ambulance, Fire Brigade, Police, coast guard, cliff and mountain rescue. You should only call this number in an EMERGENCY.

□ **111 -** Dial this number if you are need of a <u>non-emergency</u> medical help. You will be put through to the NHS Direct Service, who will go through a list of question about your non-emergency medical situation.

□ **101** - This number is for <u>non-emergency</u> police. If a crime is not currently in process, then this number is appropriate. It can also be used to give information about a crime that has already been committed.
